These video programs were transferred to DVD in October, 2007. Today condos cover what was once Alfred Johnson's hay fields. Geneva Road has been widened and the Geneva Steel Plant torn down. Several barns have disappeared. Farms have been sold; dairy cows disposed of or relocated. Most of those interviewed have since pass on and a lot of new construction and some industrialization has come to what was once the little dairy farming community of "Lake View."
