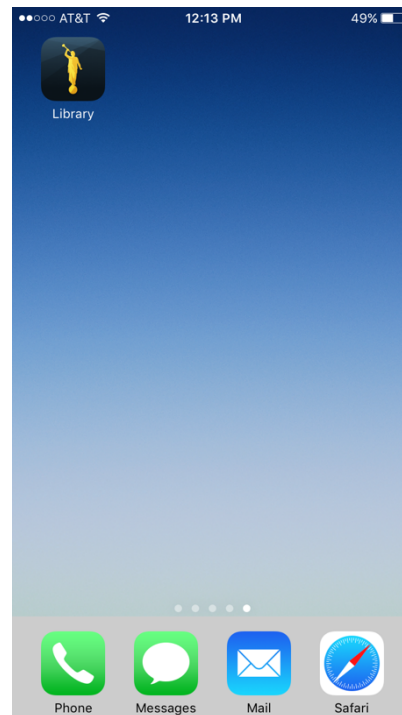

NOTE: If you already have the Gospel Library app on your device, you can skip this step

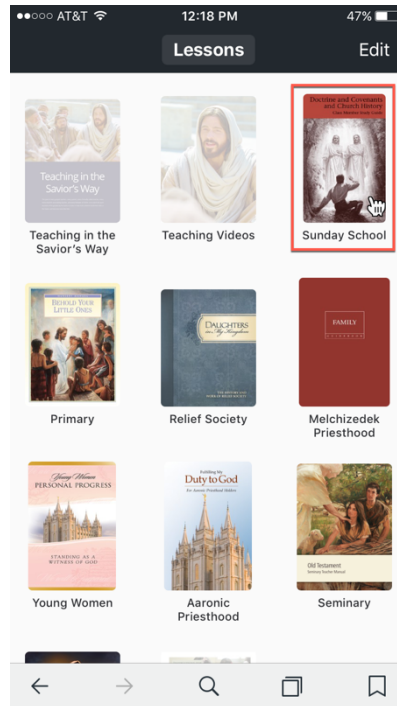
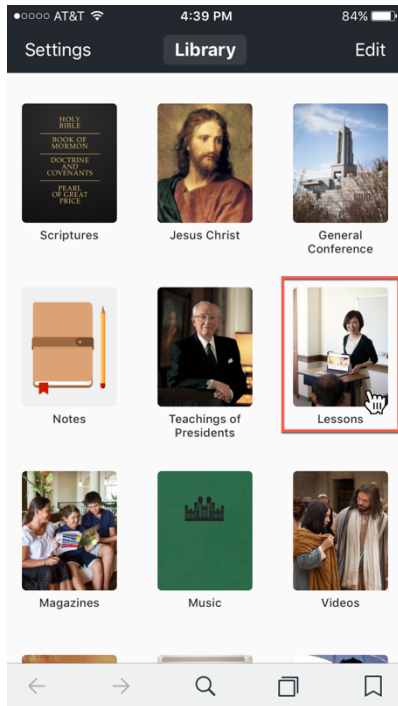
1. (Option 1) Direct link to app
 - a. (Apple): <https://itunes.apple.com/app/gospel-library/id598329798>
 - b. (Android) <https://play.google.com/store/apps/details?id=org.lds.ldssa>
2. (Option 2) Find app in app store
 - a. Open the app store for your device
 - b. Search for the term **gospel library**
 - c. Download the Gospel Library app



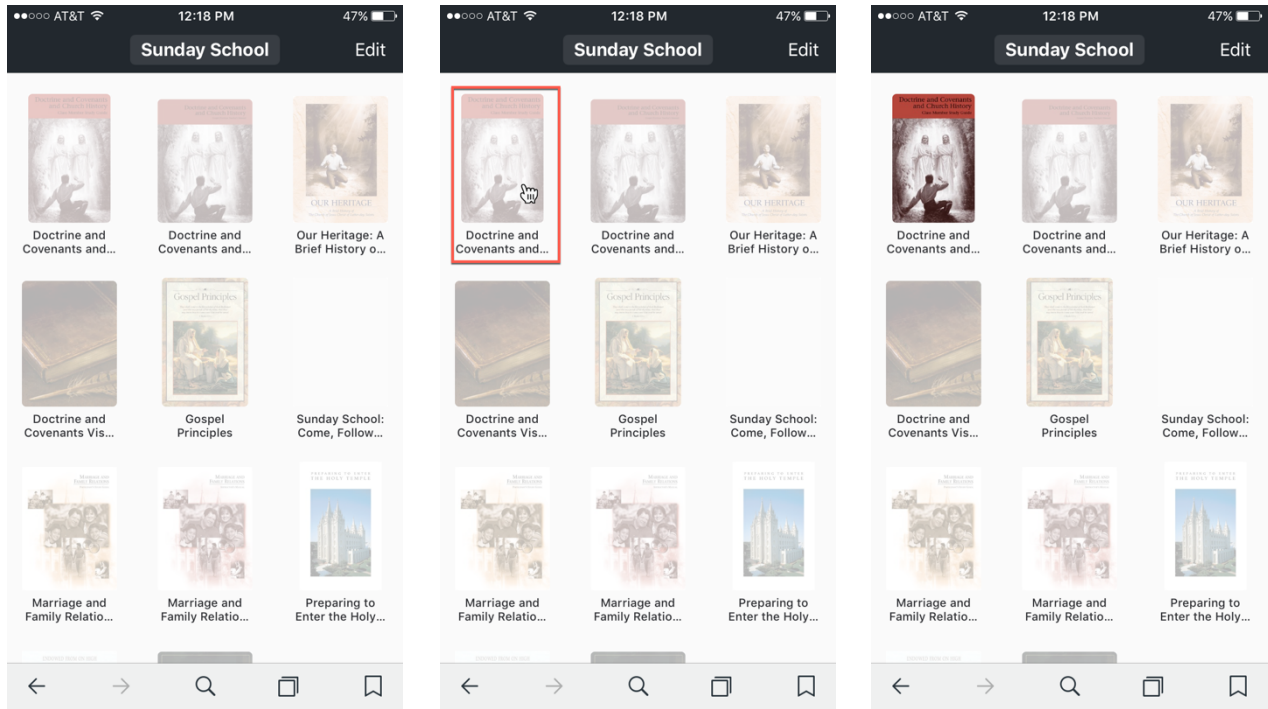
Download the content for the Doctrine and Covenants and Church History

1. Open the app and navigate to the **Library** top-level menu
2. Tap on the **Lessons** category icon
3. Tap on the **Sunday School** sub-category

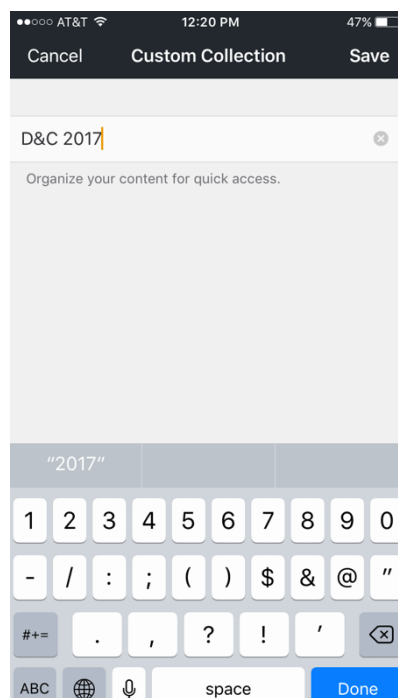
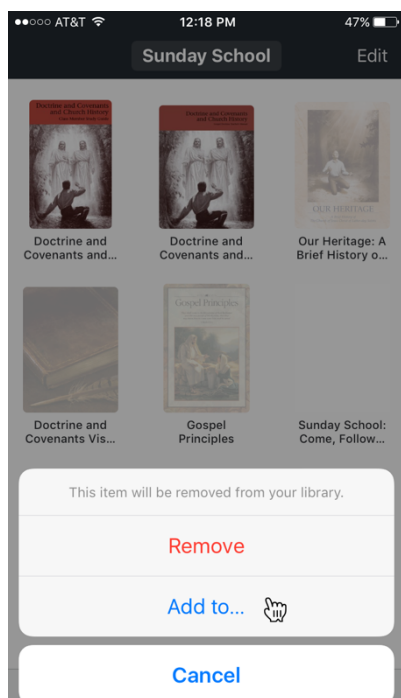
NOTE: (if within **Settings** the **List Mode** setting is toggled on, the screenshots below may appear as a list rather than as thumbnail images).



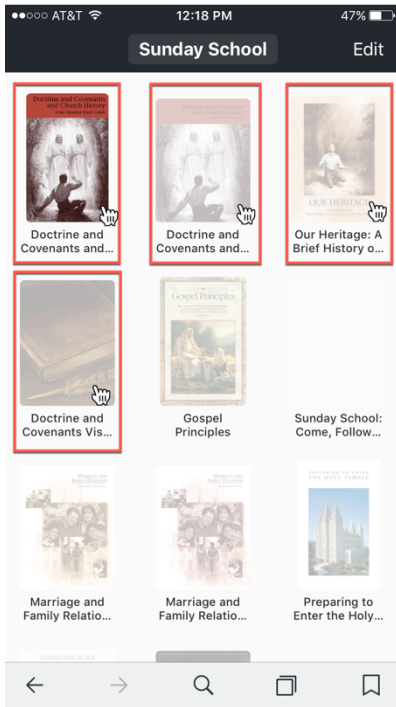
- If you haven't downloaded items before, the thumbnail images will be less opaque than those that are downloaded
- Tap on the first thumbnail image in the screenshot, that of the Doctrine and Covenants and Church History Member Study Guide. Once the item is downloaded the thumbnail image will be brighter, indicating the content for that item has been downloaded to your device



- You can create a custom folder for items you want to group together. Tap and hold an item you've downloaded. A dialog will appear asking whether you want to **Remove**, **Add to...** or **Cancel**. If you haven't yet created your custom folder, tap on **Add to...**, then on the **Custom Collection** screen give your collection/folder a name, for example **D&C 2017**. Tap **Save** when finished.

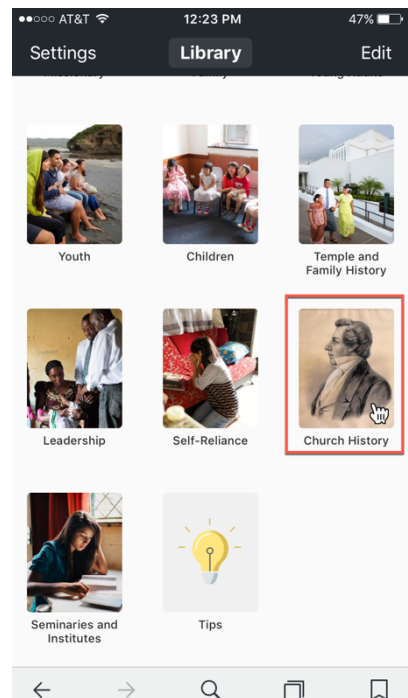
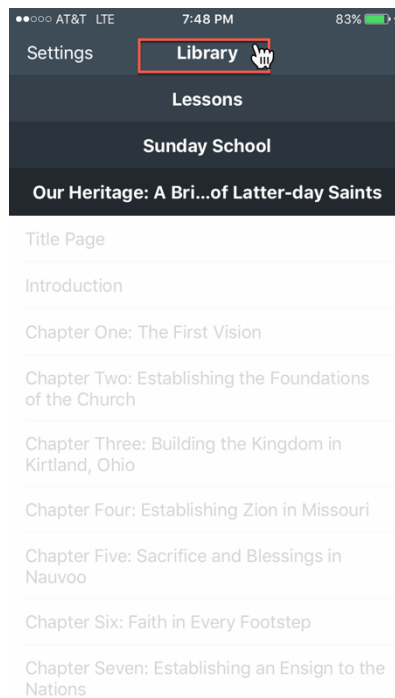
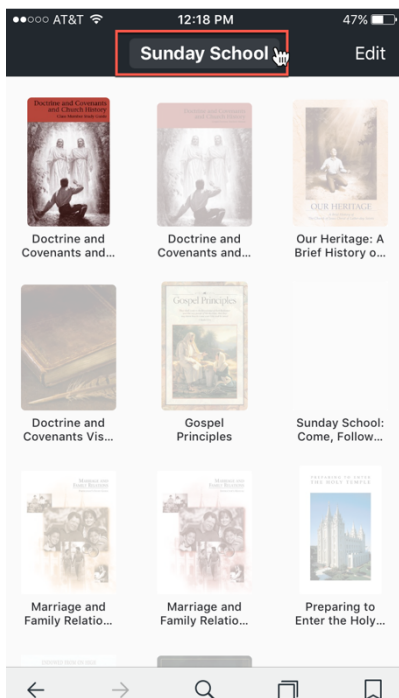


7. Back in the **Sunday School** sub-category, tap the respective thumbnail images to download the following content:
 - a. **Doctrine and Covenants and Church History Teacher's Manual**
 - b. **Our Heritage**
 - c. **Doctrine and Covenants Visual Resources**

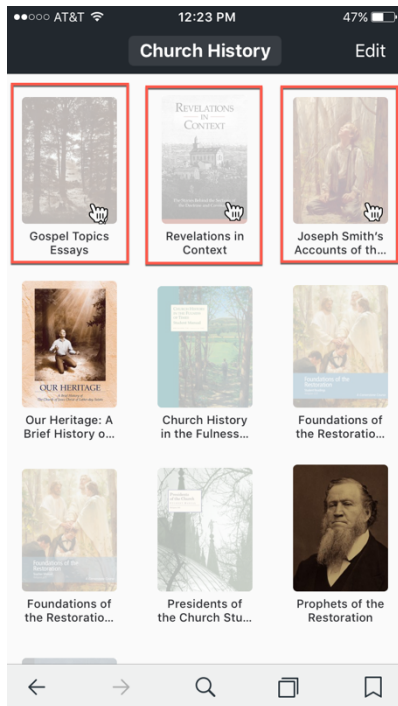


8. After the content has been downloaded, tap and hold each thumbnail image and add the content to the custom collection you previously created for easy access later.

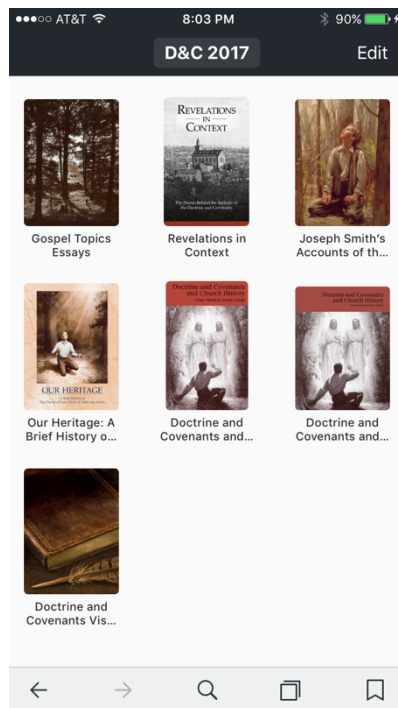
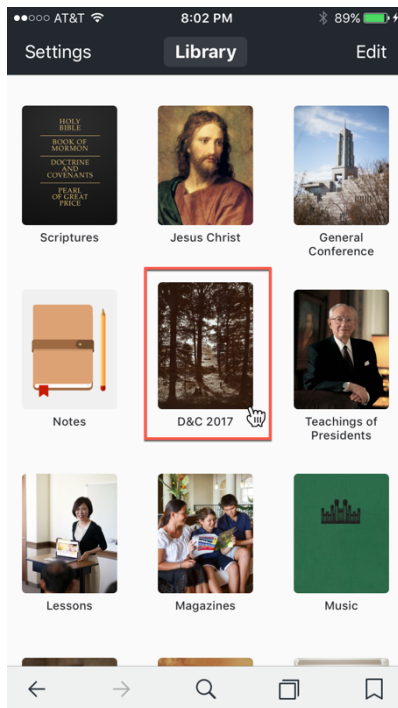
9. Tap on the **Sunday School** menu at the top of the screen then on the top-level **Library** menu to return to the top-level categories. Then scroll down the page to find the **Church History** category and tap it.



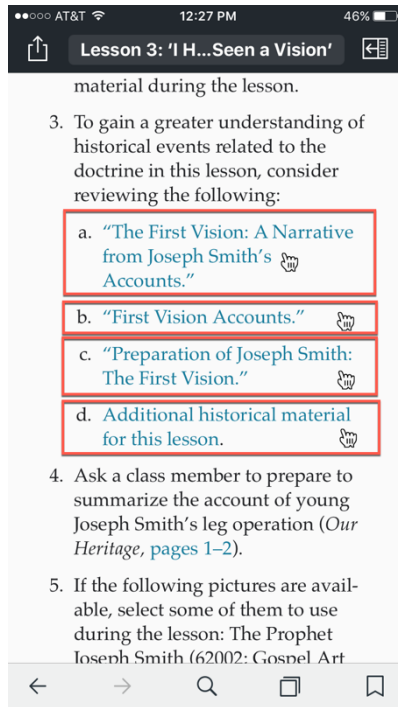
10. Within the **Church History** category, use the same steps to download the following content items and place them in your custom collection:
- Gospel Topics Essays**
 - Revelations in Context**
 - Joseph Smith's Accounts of the First Vision**



11. If you return to the top-level **Library**, you should see your custom collection. If you tap into it, you'll see all of your saved content in one convenient location



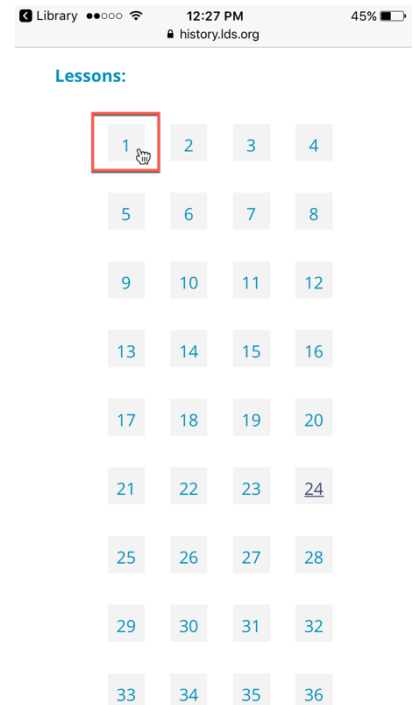
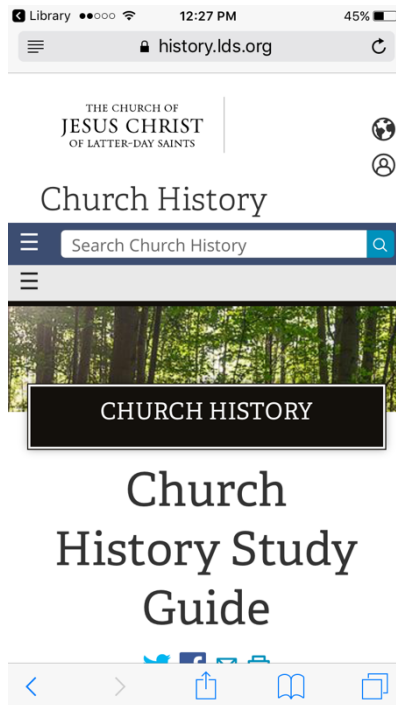
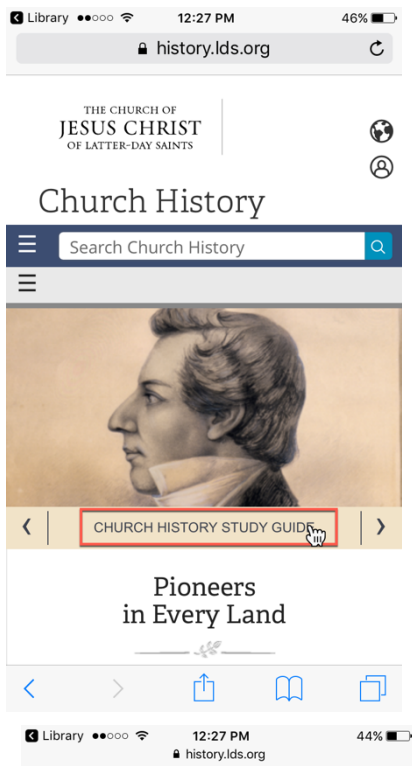
12. Even if you are not a Gospel Doctrine teacher, the Teacher's Manual has excellent additional resources for studying the Doctrine and Covenants and Church History. Many of these resources are new for 2017 and include links to **Gospel Topics** essays, **Revelations in Context**, **First Vision Accounts**, and links to the **Church History Study Guide**, which includes lesson-by-lesson links to additional church essays and resources. Access the new Church History Study Guide on history.lds.org

The Church has created a new **Church History Study Guide** to accompany the study of the Doctrine and Covenants. However, this study guide is not available through the Gospel Library as of January 2017, although it is linked to from within the Teacher's Manual as previously shown. It is accessed through history.lds.org. To navigate manually to this study guide:

1. (Option 1) Navigate directly to <https://history.lds.org/article/church-history-study-guide>
2. (Option 2) Navigate to history.lds.org on your device
 - a. Tap on the **Church History Study Guide** link on the rotating banner
3. Scroll down the page to find links to each lesson. Tap on the lesson number for the lesson you are studying.



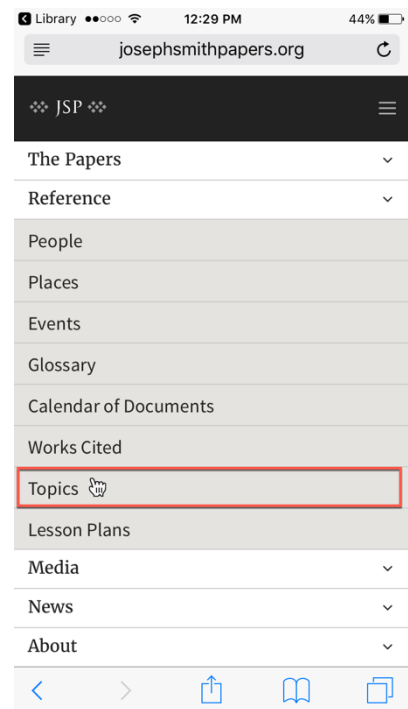
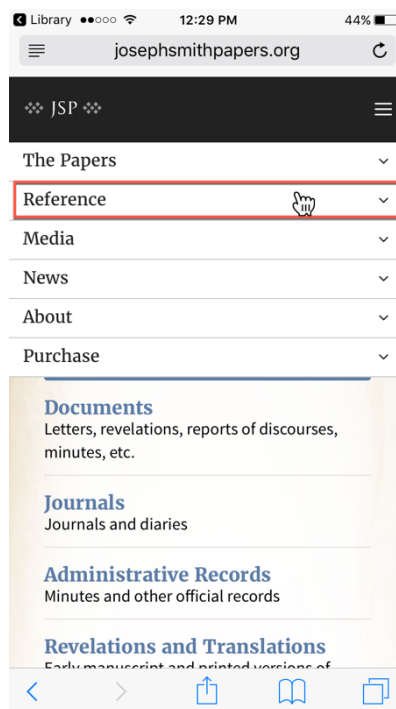
Lesson 3: "I Had Seen a Vision"

- **"First Vision Accounts":** This Gospel Topics essay introduces the different accounts of the First Vision recorded during Joseph Smith's lifetime.
- **"The First Vision: Journey to the Sacred Grove":** This multimedia narrative uses immersive images from the Smith farm and the Sacred Grove to tell how Joseph Smith's experiences led to the First Vision.
- **"Joseph Smith's Accounts of the First Vision":** In this series of short videos, scholars address differences between Joseph Smith's accounts of the First Vision.
- **Artistic Interpretations of the First Vision:** This online exhibit includes selections of artwork from the Church History Museum's collection depicting

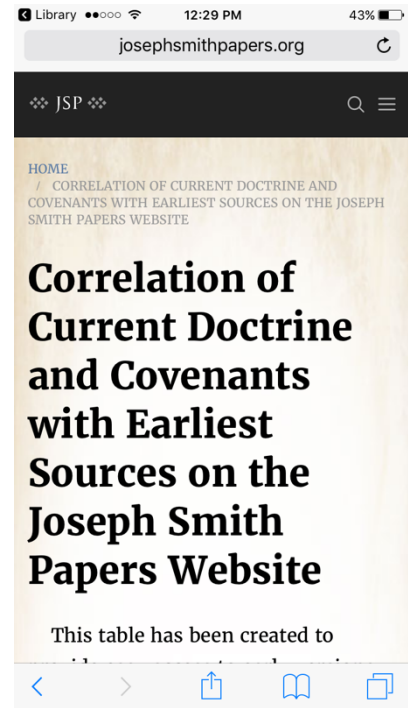
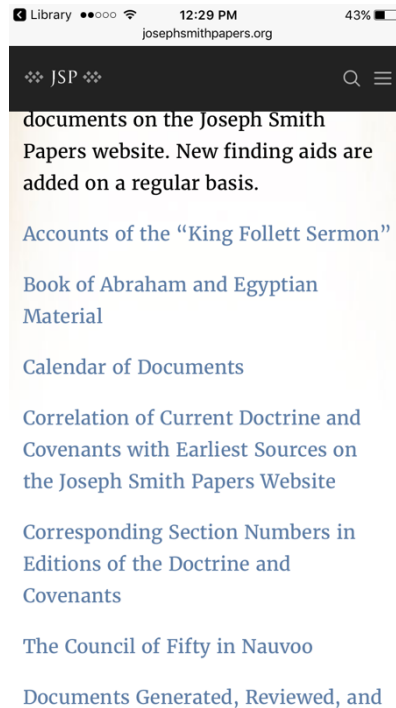
Access the Joseph Smith Papers Project

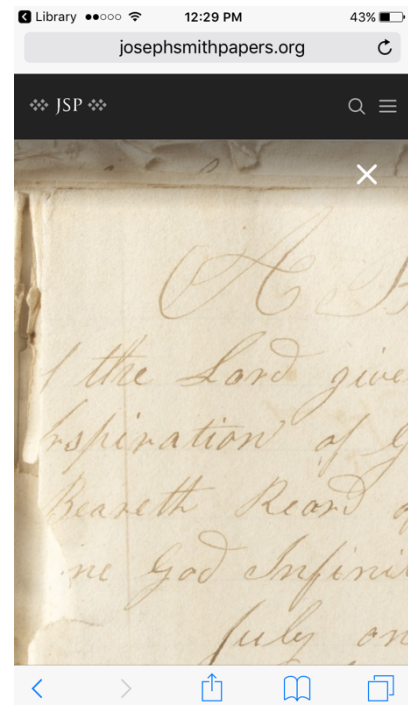
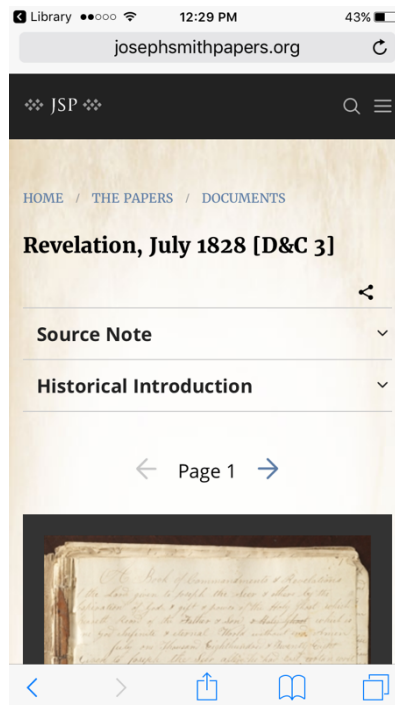

6. Pinch-and-zoom to zoom-in on the image

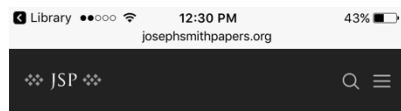
