Karen McBride, a descendent of Dominica and Harriet (Henrietta), and granddaughter of Harriet Louise, reports an error on page 69 which indicates that this couple had “no issue.” The actual spelling of the name is Boudrero which may explain the error. The couple settled in Logan on 1st East and had six children. Karen provides the following verification:

“Harriet (Henrietta Chatelain,) born 8 Feb., 1827, came to Utah in the Edmund Ellsworth Company. My cousin found a copy of the promissory note that was signed the day she arrived in the valley, 26 September 1856 in the sum of \$78.08. Harriet was married to Charles Hollin Rammell in the Endowment house on Feb. 20, 1857. Temple divorce 28 June 1858. No issue.

She married Dominco (Dominique) Bodrero in September of 1858. Their surname was later changed to French spelling (Boudrero). To date, it remains the same. They were sealed in the Endowment House on 17 October 1868. They settled in Logan, Utah and lived on 1st North between 1st and 2nd West. Together they had the following children:

Marie Harriet, born 7 August 1859; Lydia, born 23 November, 1861 and died before 1870; Josephine, born 11 June 1864; Harriet Louise, born 17 February, 1867; Lehigh Dominique, born 16 May, 1867 and Louis David Boudrero, Born 7 October 1874.

Dominque died on 10 August 1919. Harriet died 27 June 1912. Both are buried in the Logan, Utah cemetery.”
